# My Journey

I was born on Nov 16, 2003 at 25 weeks gestation via emergency C-section. I came into this world at such an early gestational age because my mom developed a life threatening condition known as HELLP Syndrome (Hemolysis Elevated Liver enzymes and Low Platelets) and they had to quickly deliver me to save her life. I weighed 15.5 oz and was 11 ¼ inches long. I had IUGR (Intra-Uterine Growth Restriction) and was the equivalent of a 21-weeker when I was born. My parents were told I had about a 5% chance of surviving, but I had a different plan. After 159 days (over 5 months) in the NICU at Georgetown University Hospital, I came home.

During my stay at the NICU I endured many of the obstacles that are presented to micro preemies like me. I was on the ventilator for 2 months and as a result I suffer from chronic lung disease (CLD/BPD), but that doesn't bother me too much now. Finally after 2 months I graduated to CPAP and much to my dismay I spent about a week with that awful thing strapped to my nose. From there I went to vapotherm (high flow humidified nasal cannula) and then finally to a regular low flow nasal cannula. I had heart surgery at one week old to close my PDA (Patent Ductus Arteriosus). My parents were really nervous that day. I had multiple blood and platelet transfusions during my first two months of life. I suffered a number of brain injuries including: a Grade I IVH, a lesion in the thalamus, suspected PVL that was later ruled out, 80% atrophy of my left cerebellum, 20% atrophy of my right cerebellum, and overall atrophy of the brain. At about a month and half old, I started having seizures and they suspected fungal meningitis, but a spinal tap grew nothing. I had so many infections and was on many powerful antibiotics throughout my stay at the NICU. I developed Stage 3+ ROP (Retinopathy of Prematurity) in my eyes, which was corrected with laser surgery. My favorite time when I was in the NICU was everyday when my parents came to visit.

I came home on oxygen, an NG tube, an apnea monitor, a pulse ox monitor, neb treatments 4 times a day, and on 10 different medications. For the first several months at home I was fed continuously through my NG tube via a pump due to risk of aspiration. I hated having that tube stuck down my nose into my tummy and was always trying to pull it out. I finally got rid of the NG tube at 9 months of age and the oxygen at 20 months of age. I also suffer from a fairly bad case of GERD (Reflux). I have quite the social calendar-visiting doctors several times a year: follow-ups with GI, ophthalmologist, pediatrician, neurologist, and developmental pediatrician to name a few. I go to private speech therapy and physical therapy and I receive occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech therapy at pre-school each week. In summer 2005 I underwent spinal surgery to correct a tethered spinal cord (TCS) and will need follow-up MRI's periodically to make sure it does not re-tether.

Today I'm 6 years old and I weigh 36 pounds. I still go to speech, physical, and occupational therapy on a weekly basis and all my therapists are so pleased with my progress. I love to practice for physical therapy on my new play set that I got for my birthday. It is so much fun to climb the rock wall, swing, and slide down the big yellow slide. I'm in kindergarten this year and I get to ride the bus to school everyday. My parents are so proud of my progress. They refer to me as their million-dollar miracle. I have no idea how much a million dollars is, but I think I might be close to getting a million dollars because the tooth fairy keeps bringing me money for losing my teeth!

I'm so happy my parents have taken such an interest in helping prematurity related causes such as the Georgetown University NICU and the March of Dimes. I spent my first 159 days of life in the NICU and I am forever grateful to all the nurses and doctors who saved my life and took such good care of me while I was there. I want to make sure they can continue saving babies like me for years to come. The March of Dimes has launched a national campaign to raise money for prematurity research to help other babies like me. I am alive today because they funded research that resulted in the development of surfactant, a substance that helped my immature lungs to develop. They even invited me to be the 2009 National Ambassador for the March of Dimes and I spent the year traveling the country sharing my story and helping in the fight against prematurity ([www.marchofdimes.com/katelynsjourney](http://www.marchofdimes.com/katelynsjourney)). I would love for you to come and join me, my parents, friends, and other supporters and play in Team Katelyn's 5th Annual Golf Tournament to raise money for these causes so other babies and families can have the same opportunities that we were given. I will be there and am looking forward to seeing you there.
